From March prescriptions will be sent electronically to a pharmacy.

If you wish to nominate a pharmacy please let reception know. Patients without a nominated pharmacy will receive a prescription token with a barcode to take to the pharmacy of their choice.

You can request your medication by using SystmOnline, in writing, or via your chosen pharmacy.

Our preferred method of receiving your prescription request is by SystmOnline. This is the most secure and efficient way of generating your repeat prescription.

To sign up for SystmOnline please bring 2 forms of ID (photo ID and proof of address) to reception. You will be asked to complete a sign up form and then be given your user name and password to access this service.
